**Pillar 1**

**Improved functioning of the formal law and justice system:** to increase the effectiveness of the formal law and justice system to meet key constitutional and statutory obligations, especially to deter crime and maintain the rule of law; and to develop and enhance partnerships between the agencies and the community in the delivery of appropriate law and justice services

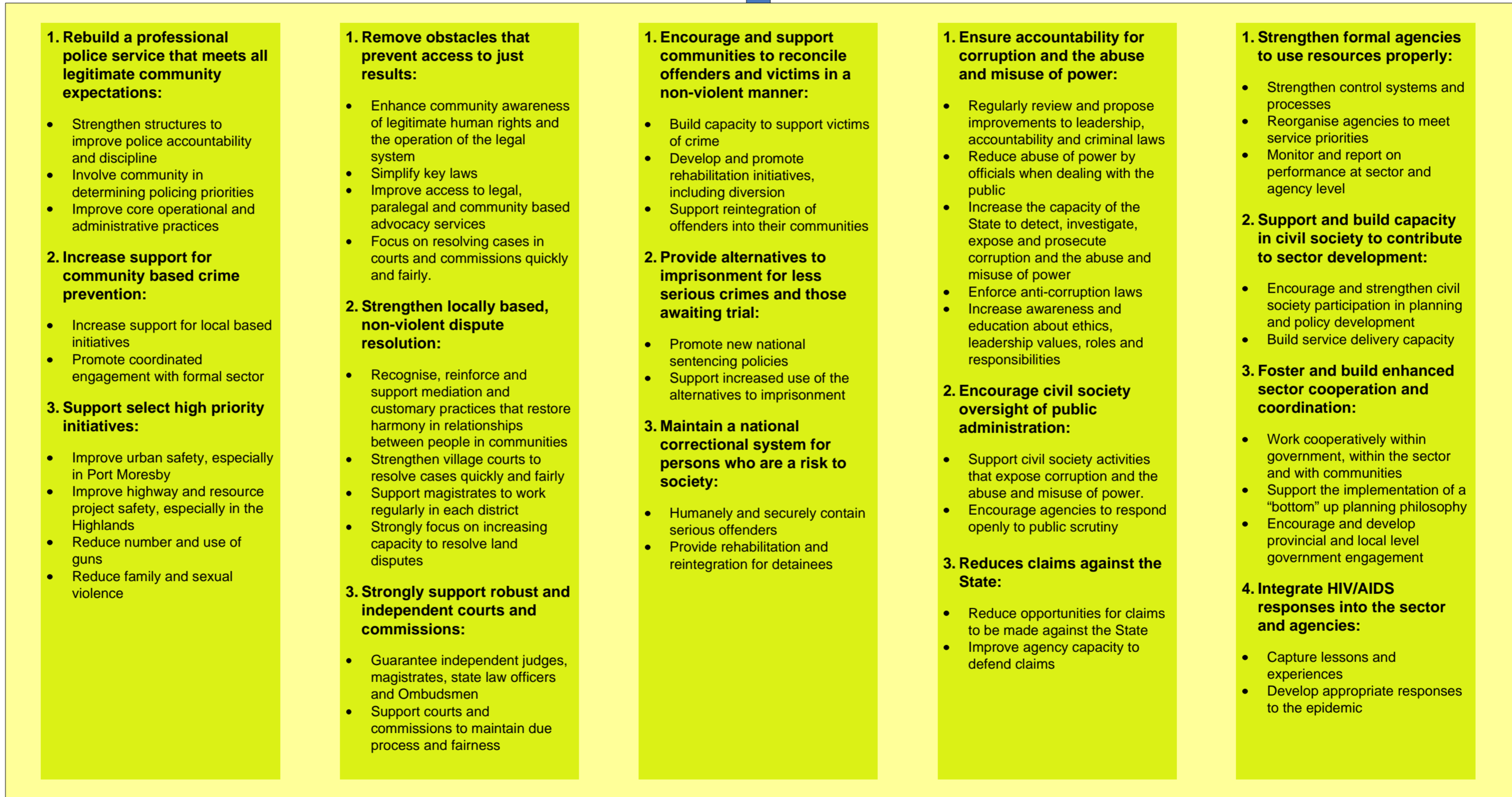
**Pillar 2**

**Improved sectoral coordination and resource use:** to foster a sectoral approach to law and justice by targeting agreed priorities and encouraging coordination and efficiencies at the policy, planning, budgeting, resource, research, monitoring and operational levels, in the context of limited resources

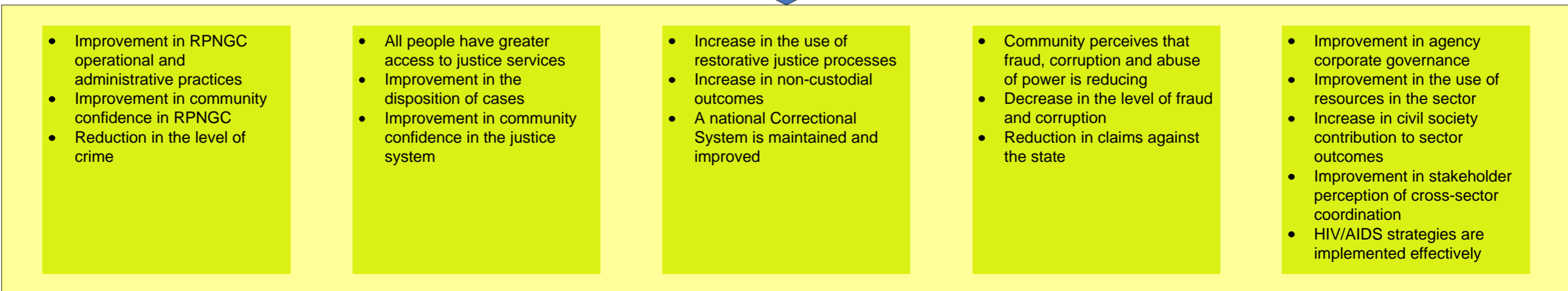
**Pillar 3**

**Increased focus on crime prevention and restorative justice:** to promote crime prevention and restorative justice interventions throughout the formal and informal systems; and to develop the informal law and justice systems as an essential and complementary part of Papua New Guinea’s law and justice system.
